- Merge onto I-465 S / I-74 E, via Exit 69
- Take I-465 S / I-74 E to I-65 S
- Merge onto I-65 S, via Exit 53 B
- Take the Worthsville Road Exit (Exit 97)
- Turn right onto Worthsville Road
- Turn left at Endress+Hauser entrance
- Arrive at 2355 Endress Place or 2350 Endress Place, Greenwood, IN 46143

To Airport from Endress+Hauser

- North on Endress Place
- Right on Worthsville Road (750N)
- Left onto I-65 N
- Take Exit 106, to I-465 W / I-74 W
- Continue on I-465 W / I-74 W

- Merge onto I-70 W, Exit 9 B, toward Terre Haute/St. Louis
